MANUFACTURER'S COMMENTS:

For outright beginners through to seasoned professionals, the 37 Sports Cabin challenges the entire notion of cruising with a more expensive, raised fly-bridge equivalent, and has the power to seduce even the most sceptical of boat buyers.

The enclosed Sports Cabin has a full length canvas top which fully retracts, along with side-opening doors, so that passengers still get a good sense of the outdoors, just as they do from our more exposed Sun Top and T Top versions.

The interior layout offers the same potential for seating up to six people around an Lshaped table, but there have been more tweaks made inside the cabin too. Found inside every Sports Cabin, for example, there's higher attention to detail, with a whole host of quality touches and improvements including a lacquered walnut wood interior, suede covered steering wheel, Nirrox 100% waterproof upholstery with white diamond patterned stitching and an electrically operated canvas roof as standard.

MANUFACTURER'S BACKGROUND:

Ever since the Axopar 28 range caught the public's imagination for the first time at its world premiere at the Helsinki Boat Show in 2014, competitors have tried but nothing has come remotely close to packaging such devastatingly cool looks with an exhilarating

driving experience, and incredible value-for-money.

With its elongated hull lines and sharp, angular features, suddenly here was a concept that not only looked like nothing we had seen before, but cleverly conceived 'modular' options gave the range full versatility and created wide customer appeal, changing the way people perceived boating almost overnight.

Since 2014, Axopar Boats has grown to become one of Europe's top ten powerboat producers and is comfortably regarded as the biggest boat producer in the Nordic countries. As a privately owned company, Axopar is amongst the most financially stable companies in the leisure boating market.

Today, Axopar directly employs about 120 persons across 5 offices in Europe, and together with its OEM partners, employs over 650 persons in total. The company has always stood without any debt and is officially listed by the Financial Times as one of the fastest growing European companies. Year by year, Axopar develops sales in existing markets with more than 3,500 boats built so far, through a network of approximately 100 dealers in more than 50 countries.
